

Elkton City Council
Special Meeting Minutes
March 16, 2026

The special meeting of the Elkton City Council was called to order at 6:03 PM by Mayor Charles Remund. Council members present were David Bierman, Tal Farnham, Brooke Greve, Emily Schelske, and Rick Weible. Council member Scott Stuefen was not in attendance. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss nuisance property and procedures.

Motion by Weible, second by Bierman to approve the agenda as presented. All in favor – motion carried.

The council discussed the property at 203 Cornell. The resident living on the property is living in an unauthorized structure. Consulting with the attorney there were several ways to move forward with court proceedings. The council chose to file a complaint against the owner and bring on eviction action against the resident as other requests have not been complied with. Motion by Weible, second by Bierman to have the lawyer move with the complaint and eviction. All in favor – motion carried.

Discussion was held on how to move forward with other nuisance property issues. The code enforcement officer sends out letters and then sends duplicates to the finance office with a report of progress. It was decided that there will be a standing agenda item for the nuisance report.

With no further business before the council the meeting was adjourned with a motion by Greve, second by Farnham at 6:13 PM. All in favor – motion carried.
